I am writing with regards to a recent letter you received from Brian's Epilepsy Nurse Alison Knowles. This letter identified that Brian is currently having some difficulties within his workplace, and as a result this is affecting his seizure pattern.

As we offer a five-year back up service to our clients, we would welcome the opportunity to reintroduce support into the work environment. We would propose that our Occupational Psychologist Gavin Thurgood and myself meet with you and Brian to discuss an appropriate action plan. We would then carry out a Job Analysis within the environment, in order to identify the difficulties that Brian is experiencing. This will allow us to identify appropriate compensatory strategies to introduce into Brian's working environment, in order to enable him to carry out his daily duties more effectively.

I would like to stress however, that any issues regarding Personnel would continue to be dealt with between Dunlop, Brian and the Union, and we have no desire to become involved within these issues. The support that we would like to offer is practical support and related directly with the duties that Brian participates in.

I look forward to hearing from you to arrange a mutually convenient meeting to discuss these issues.
